\*The Production staff will be headed up by members of the Centennial Theater team, including Theater Director Eric Webster, Set and Props designer Kris Schmidt, and Lighting Designer Keara Lavandowska.

\*In addition, Centennial High School Theatre students will also be on the team and helping with the production, supervision, and leading our theatre games! Giving the students who are registered for the production a chance to interact and bond with students in the Centennial High School Theatre program!

\*All students registered will be required to provide their own “Base Costume” of all-black clothing. Black pants (No shorts) and a black shirt (No writing images or patterns on the black shirt). They also need to provide comfortable shoes that they wear every day and can move in easily. No sandals, Crocs, heels or flipflops. Preferably, these shoes should also be black. We will provide the accessories for the costuming for the show.

\*Due to safety procedures and protocols, all Parents/Guardians or caregivers of the registered students will NOT be allowed in the building/PAC until the show on the evening of June 16. Students must be dropped off at the PAC door (Door S11) and will be met and brought in by staff. Students will be released at 5:00 and can be picked up outside door S11. Staff will stay on

hand until each student is safely with their Parents/Guardians or caregivers. PLEASE arrive on time to pick up your student. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
