

2025-2026 Centennial Theatre Booster Scholarship Details

The Centennial Theater Boosters seeks to recognize the achievements of seniors who have participated in the program throughout their time at Centennial High School.

Scholarship money is raised by the boosters through fundraising events and community donations.

- This scholarship is for any graduating Centennial High School senior who has participated in at least one of the following: Improv, One Act, the fall play, or the spring musical as a cast or crew for at least 3 years, with one of those years being your senior year. Scholarships will be awarded to students who have fostered our belief of “Where Everyone Belongs” and to those who have demonstrated acts of community service, as well as leadership abilities during their time in Centennial Theatre.
- Applicants must complete this application which includes an essay and letter of recommendation and a list of volunteer activities.

Theater Appreciation Scholarships: 4 @ \$500 scholarships to seniors who have been involved in and dedicated to Centennial Theatre. To apply for this scholarship, you must write a 1 page essay highlighting what the theater mission of “Where Everyone Belongs” has meant to you, and what you have learned during your years in this program. Also consider the impact you have left on the Centennial theatre community. You will need to submit 1 letter of recommendation from an adult who knows you outside of the theater department, but cannot be from a parent or relative. This letter should state why they believe you deserve this scholarship. You will also need to complete 15 hours of community volunteer work outside of the theater department. These can be recorded on the form found on the theatre website and uploaded to the Google Form application.

If you will be going on to study theatre in college, you may also qualify for an extra \$500 through the:

Thespian Scholarship: up to 2 @ \$500 scholarships to seniors who have been involved in and dedicated to Centennial Theatre AND plan on majoring or minoring in theatre in college. Please make sure to document your proposed study details in the Google Form to include what you will be studying in college. This scholarship will be paid to the recipients at the end of their freshman year of college, and a proof of completion will need to be submitted. Proof of completion of your year in theatre must be provided through a college transcript or on institution letterhead from a college theatre director. If a Thespian Scholarship recipient does not end up majoring or minoring in theatre, their Thespian Scholarship will be forfeited. The deadline to submit proof of completion is June 1, 2027.

Deadline: April 16, 2026

Applications will be reviewed by the Centennial Theatre Boosters Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of individuals who do not have current seniors.

Recipients will be announced at the annual Recognition and Reveal Party at the end of the school year.

Scholarships are awarded for education at a two and/or four-year public or private college or university, community college, technical college, or an accredited professional school. Checks to be written to the recipient and the post secondary institution once verifications are met.
